

There has been a need for inspection of the mobile electrical requirements both current and future within the Marine Corps for a while. Over the years there have been many opportunities presented to correct this deficiency. CWO-3 Schneider Robert, C. has been assigned to Systems Command as Special Projects Officer to promulgate this study as his main focus of effort over the next two years. Two main areas he is looking for input are the Utilities Officers and other duty experts (1169's) in the field and the program managers at Systems Command. Systems Command concern is that they are not purchasing and fielding the right size/type of generator and MEPDIS equipment.

GOALS: Determine the current use, short-term trends, and long-term requirements of equipment requiring expeditionary power. The outcome of the study will provide the Marine Corps with the ability to provide the right mix and balance to satisfy current and future expeditionary power needs.
