

MAGTF Integration Section's role in the Marine Corps Engineer Center of Excellence is to focus on those functions external to formal instruction while the academic structure continues to provide the quality education traditionally performed at MCES. The section coordinates with and supports multiple agencies IOT improve unity of effort within the engineer community. ECOE does not assume any of the functions or responsibilities of those agencies but provides resources and SME recommendations not inherent in those organizations. The following core functions are the responsibility of the MAGTF Integration:

- Provide Action Officers and coordinate support and SME representation for MCWL experimentation and MCSC acquisition programs.
- Coordinate with Operating Forces to enhance communication and unity of effort on engineer initiatives.
- Coordinate with Doctrine Division, Marine Corps Combat Development Command and serve as the proponent for engineer doctrinal publications.
- Maintain and update the Engineer Training and Readiness Manual.

Assist in developing engineering TTPs that reflect the results of experimentation and acquisitions programs, Subject Matter Expert (SME) recommendations, available intelligence and Lessons Learned from Operating Forces.
