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Piney Green Gate commuters to experience slower traffic patterns due to construction

CAMP LEJEUNE, N.C. – Beginning Feb. 1, base employees and commercial truck drivers are advised they will experience slower traffic patterns at the Piney Green Gate entrance as traffic is re-routed to temporary lanes of travel.

The new lanes will re-route drivers around ongoing construction and re-merge with the existing Piney Green road just before the pedestrian bridge. “With traffic safely redirected, work can begin on a new gate house, entrance canopy, active barrier, and a more efficient commercial vehicle inspection facility,” explained Commander Cheryl Hansen, Officer-in-Charge of Construction.

“We are also going to create six additional traffic turning lanes at the Piney Green/Route 24 intersection to mitigate congestion,” Hansen said.

Base commuters can expect this new traffic pattern to remain in effect until construction is complete in early April, subject to weather delays. They are also advised to heed the 15 MPH posted speed limit while driving through the construction zone.

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
