FED LOG

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1. Terminal Learning Objective: Given an Equipment Repair Order Shopping/Transaction List (EROSL) and the references, process an EROSL (NAVMC 10925), to ensure timely and accurate data input into the AIS until all requisitioned parts are received or cancelled.
2. Enabling Learning Objective: Given the EROSL and the references, identify the characteristics of FED LOG, per the references.

OUTLINE

1. **FEDERAL LOGISTICS INFORMATION SYSTEM (FED LOG)**

a. Purpose: FED LOG is a logistics information system that allows you to retrieve information from its database quickly. FED LOG provides the power of a personal computer with the advanced of storage technology of CD-ROM (Compact Disc-Read Only memory) which allows for quick searching of the FLIS database which are listed below.

- (1) Cross reference; Part Number & Stock Number
- (2) Management data
- (3) Freight
- (4) Supplier, also known Commercial and Government
Entity
- (5) Characteristics

(6) Representative Drawing

b. FED LOG can also provide information that is specific to particular DOD/GSA service agencies.

c. Sponsor: This system is sponsored by Defense Logistics Agency, Battle Creek, MI with the cooperation of Marine Corps Logistics Base, Albany, Georgia.

d. Update: Monthly, Distribution according to the quantities indicated on the publication list (PL)

e. Format: Compact Disk, read only memory (CD-ROM), Set of (4)

2. FED LOG PROGRAMS

a. FED LOG is made up of two programs.

(1) Interactive- a program that provide on-screen instructions and menus for entering a query, performing a search, viewing data, and printing data. Interactive also allows you to search even if you don't know the NSN of the item you are seeking.

(2) Batch- a program that allows you to enter multiple queries that will be run sequentially.

3. INTERACTIVE-SCREEN STRUCTURE

a. Menus/Function Keys: The screen has a series of menus (in Windows) and function Keys (in DOS) that give you access to basic functionality such as printing, dataview selection.

b. The are six basic FED LOG menus:

(1) File

(2) Edit

(3) Dataviews

(4) Service

(5) View

(6) Help

c. In Windows, these menus are always available on the menu bar at the top of the FED LOG screen, regardless of where you are in the program.

4. INTERACTIVE QUERY

a. Find NSN 5306-00-225-8504. Enter the required data on your student outline. Once your search is completed and you have extracted the desired information, go back to the Query by hitting the F2 key.

b. The following data is required:

- (1) Source of Supply
- (2) Quantity unit pack
- (3) Unit of Issue
- (4) Unit Price
- (5) Recoverability Code
- (6) Stores Account Code
- (7) Combat Essentially Code
- (8) Phrase Code
- (9) Phrase Statement
- (10) Mgmt Ctrl factor data
