6. PURPOSE. The purpose of this program of instruction is to provide a Marine with the knowledge and skills required to be awarded MOS 0351, Infantry Assaultman, and to perform as an assaultman or a Javelin assistant gunner in an infantry assault or a Javelin squad.

7. SCOPE. This course is designed to train Marines in the knowledge and skills required to perform as an assaultman or Javelin team assistant gunner in an infantry assault or Javelin squad. The Marine receives training in individual weapons, munitions, land navigation, combat conditioning, communications, nuclear, biological, and chemical protection, offensive techniques, defensive techniques, scouting and patrolling techniques, military operations on urban terrain techniques, MK153 SMAW operations, basic demolition techniques, armor vehicle identification, and Javelin Weapon System operations. Upon successful completion of this course, a Marine receives MOS 0351 and is capable of performing as an assaultman or a Javelin team assistant gunner in an infantry assault or a Javelin squad.
