**6. PURPOSE. The purpose of this program of instruction is to provide a Marine with the knowledge and skills required to be awarded MOS 0352, Infantry Anti-Tank Guided Missileman, and to perform as an anti-tank guided missileman in an infantry anti-tank squad.**

**7. SCOPE. This course is designed to train Marines in the knowledge and skills required to perform as an anti-tank guided missileman in an infantry anti-tank squad. The Marine receives training in individual weapons, munitions, land navigation, combat conditioning, communications, nuclear, biological, and chemical protection, offensive techniques, defensive techniques, scouting and patrolling techniques, military operations on urban terrain techniques, M220E4 TOW2 weapon system operations, armor vehicle identification, and HMMWV licensure. Upon successful completion of this course, a Marine receives MOS 0352 and is capable of performing as an anti-tank guided missileman in an infantry anti-tank squad.**
